



What is “alt text” and why is it important?

- ~~Including the image, an alternative description or alt text image that you are expecting users to perceive by * - / 3 / à 4 * 0~~
- ~~Optional alt text describing the fully loaded image, which may be included in the image caption. This may not be~~
- ~~This describes the image in the best single-line of text, and additional text should only be used if it is necessary.~~

Complex images

If the image contains too much information to include in concise alt text:
